Tonight is a magical elegant evening, we have gathered to honor, acknowledge, and celebrate. I want to thank each of you for coming out to support Coppin State University. Since 1900 Coppin State has stood as a beacon of hope, and over the past 124 years, we have distinguished ourselves as a university that is invaluable and irreplaceable.

What started in the basement of a local high school, is today a leading urban university recognized nationally for its academic programs in Business, Healthcare, Psychology, Teacher Education, Criminal Justice, Social Work, and STEM, and the demand for the Coppin experience is growing – this is why we are attracting students from 37 states, including the District of Columbia, and 31 countries.

Education remains the greatest equalizer in our nation, and this is precisely why our work at Coppin State is so important. We educate and prepare a diverse, multicultural, multi-generational student population who at the hands of our incredible faculty and staff are transformed into the thought-leaders, innovators, solution finders, and change agents that are helping to shape and lead our nation.

As Maryland's most affordable four-year college or university, we work to ensure cost is never a factor that exclude students from receiving a life changing quality education and they can do so without having to incur crippling debt. - Won two MEAC Conference Championships; and

I see men and women who enjoy a better quality of life, because somebody believed in them, and somebody was willing to invest in their future.

Every one of us in this room owes a debt we cannot repay, but we can – this evening, begin by paying it forward.

Your being here is not by chance, let's be clear you could have been anywhere this evening, but you made a conscious choice - a choice that put you in the right place, at the right time, hearing precisely what you were meant to hear.

Your presence represents your belief in Coppin State, our mission, and our unwavering commitment to transforming lives. Individually and collectively, you understood the assignment, and for that I am grateful. Tonight is bigger than a good meal and looking great (and yes you look great). But tonight is about impact, legacy, and a commitment to Do More and help someone BEMORE.

What good comes from acquiring wealth and rising to profound levels of influence, if we use that wealth and influence to only enrich ourselves? I am reminded of Dr. Winky Camphor. Winky was one of Coppin's most devoted alumni. His heart, spirit, and soul bled "Blue and Gold." Winky was a retired educator – and by no means was he a rich man, yet he understood you don't have to be to make a difference.

Winky was always asking "how can I help and what can I do?" and he never asked for anything in return. His philanthropic heart was non-transactional. Winky gave with sincere authenticity. The vision I have for our beloved Coppin State University, to – *increase student achievement*, *attain academic excellence, become a research university, elevate Eagle athletics*, and *grow our endowment* is ambitious and cannot be accomplished in isolation – it will require the help of a village.

Together we can be greater than the sum of our individual ambitions. Each of us possess the ability to put into motion a rippling effect that can change the course of this university and the lives of the students we educate.

Your support of Coppin is a strong indicator that you accept the challenge that - it is not someone's else responsible, it is our responsibility, to stand in the gap and ensure these students complete their journey.

Because of your generosity and contribution, this evening a Coppin students' hope in humanity is restored, and their dream of becoming a college graduate is closer to fruition.
